Level 2 – PBIS SILVER AWARD:

The Silver award recognizes schools that have successfully implemented school-wide PBIS and can provide a minimum of two years of annual trend data. Baseline data may be provided, but will only be considered for recognition if it is the first year of a two-year trend.

Since the application must be submitted during the school year, and annual trend data is not available until the year has ended, schools are required to provide monthly behavioral trend data to demonstrate current year positive effects. A chart is provided to compare a portion of the current school year through a month_ to_ month comparison, (August 2016 through January 2017 compared to August 2017 through January 2018).

While the goal at level two is to show positive data trends, it is recognized that schools at the highest levels of performance may reach or surpass the MSDE criteria. Schools that meet or exceed criteria as established in the Code of Maryland Annotated Regulation (COMAR) shall document maintenance of a high trend and note the criteria met or surpassed in the narrative.

Schools applying for Silver recognition must submit data points on time and complete Attachment B.
