Grade 7 Sexual Health Unit

- Understanding Gender: Identity, Biology & Expression (DVXXXX). This program explores the modern gender spectrum. Experts Dr. Eli Green, Jaymie Campbell, and Alessia Palanti define pertinent terms like cisgender, transgender, gender identity, gender expression and pronouns. Viewers learn about gender norms and stereotypes that affect all people, no matter how they identify on the gender spectrum. Students also hear from Nicole and Wayne Maines, a father-daughter pair who explain their family's unique journey with gender. Teens describe their personal experiences with gender and explain the critical importance of allies in their lives.
- *Human Reproduction and Childbirth* (DV0209) Provides an overview of the reproductive systems and fetal development. 21 minutes; 2009.
- **Then One Year (V1857)** This video covers information about the reproductive systems as well as secondary sex characteristics. 23 minutes; 1992.
- Your Body: Reproductive Systems (V2163) Focuses on parts and functions of the reproductive systems and the stages of fetal development. 16 minutes; 1994.
- *Fetal Development* (V2365) This video describes the nine months of development of the human fetus from fertilization to birth. 14 minutes; 1988.
- **Preview of a Birth (V2365)** This video chronicles the journey from conception to birth, with a full-color view of life within the womb. 15 minutes; 1991.
- Ultrasound: Eyewitness to the Earliest Days of Life (V2161) Viewers will witness the mystery of life in the womb and gain an understanding of the growth and development of each individual. 25 minutes; 1991.
- Fetal Development: A Nine Month Journey (DV0208) The program shows the process of fetal development from fertilization to birth. 14 minutes; 2004.
- **Beginnings of life From Conception to Baby (DV0100)** CC The focus of this video is on the stages of fetal development. 30 minutes; 2011.

The program addresses the topics of biological changes for boys and girls, introduction to reproduction, and safety.15 minutes, 2006.
- *Abstinence First: Teen Birth Control Decisions* (Version Distributed to each high school). The video emphasizes the benefits of abstinence and provides information about birth control. 30 minutes, 2001.
