WHO: Adults, 18 & older, interested in supporting students with Special Needs in the school setting. Education, training, or job-related experiences working with children with disabilities preferred.

HOW: Under the direction of a Special Education Interdisciplinary Team and Classroom Teacher, you will: build relationships with students and staff, support students meeting academic and behavioral goals, collect data, and implement support plans throughout the school day.

WHEN: Beginning Tuesday, September 4th. Support staff will work 6.5 hours a day, which includes a 30-minute unpaid lunch. Start & stop times are determined by the assigned school. This support position follows the student schedule**.

**When students are in school, staff reports. When students are off of school (Professional Development Days, etc.), staff does not report. When students have a late arrival or early dismissal, support staff reports at the same time as the students.
