The snow squall that went through the County did not produce significant additional accumulations. However, winds during the past few hours have caused snow drifts mostly in the western part of the County. Winds also are assisting with drying out the roadways. We are holding a small crew in our Central and West zones to address any snow drift concerns during the evening rush hour and de-mobilizing the remaining staff.

We are going back to normal operations - all roadway related overnight/weekend calls will be directed from Central Communications to appropriate Highways personnel to respond. This is the last update for this event.

Snow Event #5, Day 2 0530 Hrs Update...

Good Wednesday morning.

Crews have completed plowing/salting all roadways around 11pm last night before coming back to the shops. Primary roadways looked pretty decent last night except for very few icy spots, some local roadways had little bit of freeze before we could get to them but they were passable. All of our trucks are checking their routes as of 5am this morning to see if there are any areas that need to be addressed before the morning rush hour. Temperatures are below 20 County wide (closer to 20 in Elkridge versus 10 in Woodbine). Based on the current forecast, we are expecting a batch of snow to move through our area between noon and 1pm but not expecting significant accumulations from it.

It is cold outside, don't forget to bundle up this morning. On a brighter note, temperatures are going to be in low 50's by Sunday. Watch out for any icy spots on your way to work and be safe driving.

Next update (if needed) will be around 1300 Hrs.

Snow Event # 5, 1900 Hrs Update...

Snow started to fall around 1pm this afternoon. We started our salting operations around 2:30pm and currently wrapping up salting all County roadways. We will take a break and get dinner after we complete salting operation.

We received around 2 inches of snow in Ellicott City and temperatures are currently below 32 degrees and forecasted to continue to drop to teens overnight and stay below high 20's all day tomorrow. Salt has been working well and most of our primary roadways are just wet. After dinner, we will we go back to all of our roadways (primary and local roadways) to plow off any snow /slush from the roadways and apply salt before it freezes. Once the plow/salt operations are completed, staff will come back to the shops and rest for the night.

We plan on going back around 0500 Hrs to check for icy spots and treat as needed be ready for morning rush hour. Superintendents of each Highway Zones will address all overnight calls from Central Communications.

Next update for this event will be around 0700 Hrs tomorrow (01/30/2019)

### **Key Partners-**

DPW Highways has treated all roadways and is now handling calls for spot treatments. While there still could be some areas of packed snow, there have been no areas noted where travel is significantly impeded.

DPW Utilities and Facilities have our County facilities ready for employees and visitors with the caveat that the extremely cold temperatures makes salt better for traction than melting - so some snow and crunchy spots remain.

Howard County CAO Robbins has indicated that County Government will open and operate as scheduled today. A couple delays to note: DC area Federal operations are on a 3-hour delay / telework and MD State is on statewide liberal leave for 3 hours.

The Howard County 911 Center reports only one major incident overnight, an overturned tractor trailer on Rt. 70 which has been subsequently cleared and the roadway reopened. They also report the impact of a water main break at Rt. 1 and Guilford Rd with outages for some commercial properties and about 50 homes - Utilities is working hard to repair it.

***NWS Forecast for next couple days which ends with some sunny above freezing weather. We do have a Wind Advisory in effect during the day today and a Wind Chill Advisory in effect overnight tonight.***

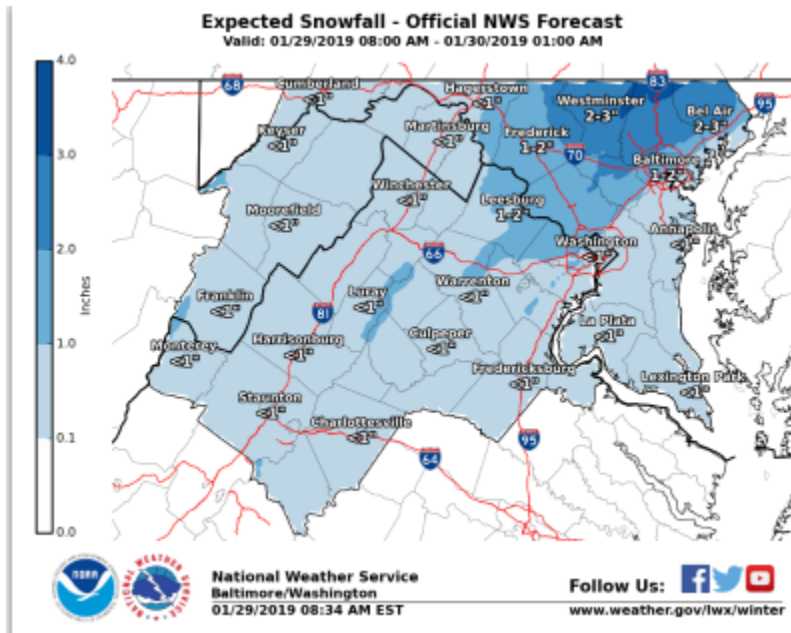

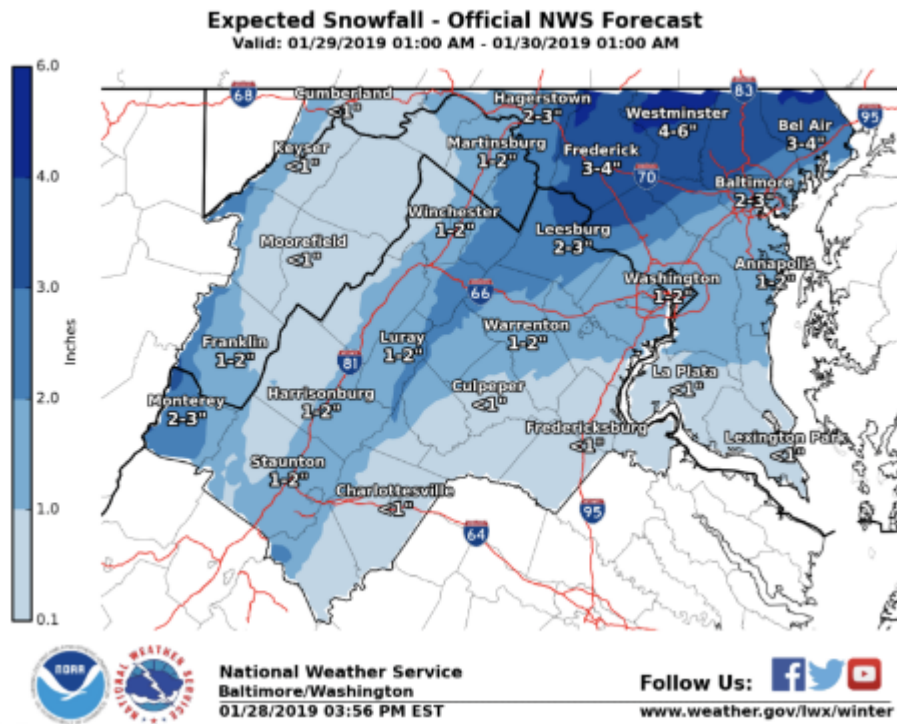

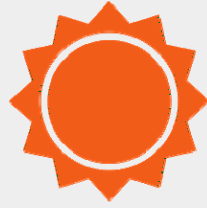
