- What do families/students of color, FARMS, and ELL say about their experience? Do they feel supported but their teachers/admin? Where are the disconnects? Is there an honest, trusting space for them to share this information?
- What are the teachers' experiences? What do they see as barriers? What are some potential solutions? How has this information been/or can be collected?
- Are there patterns based on the demographics in the school (majority minority, % of FARMS, primarily homogeneous, high income, etc.) that influence gaps?
- What are the best practices and interventions that have demonstrated success here and nationally that would be applicable here? What evidence do we have that our interventions work? Do we follow kids? Is there continuity of service?
- What are the goals for staff development? To what end? To address bias, engage students? How is it all aligned to closing the gaps?

Root Cause:

- Have any tools such as surveys or interviews been used to determine root cause and barriers?
- What incidents of bias that have occurred in the system for as long as they have been collected, where they are housed, who reviews them, how are they processed, how that information is collected and analyzed?

Narrowing Gap:

• Please provide the number of years each program has been in existence, how they are aligned to the barriers/gaps and how their success is measured.

Increasing Graduation Rates by Increasing Student Engagement

• Please provide research and best practices on which the outlined strategies are based and what the plan is moving forward. How are they aligned to the root causes and how will you know they are working? Why were these chosen?

Also, both CR99-2019 (school capacity charts) and CB17-2019 (extending schools test waiting period) are on the agenda for this Friday morning's legislative work session (6/21 at 10:00 a.m.).
