Good morning Ms. Hoffmann,

We consolidated a search based on similar parameters provided by several requesters in order to get an idea of the scope review of these records would entail. Due to the extensive time this would involve for HCPSS staff based on the various requests (well over the two hours allotted free of charge per request) we are first looking for ways to narrow or discuss further as a collective.

Additionally, the MPIA process is not private. In fact, once an MPIA request is submitted to HCPSS it becomes a public record meaning anyone can request information about such requests, including who submitted them. There are certain instances where information requested may be

private to the requester (such as a request for records about an individual student for which only the parent/guardian may receive such records), but otherwise details about a request would generally be public information.

I hope that helps answer your questions, please let me know if you would like to discuss further.
