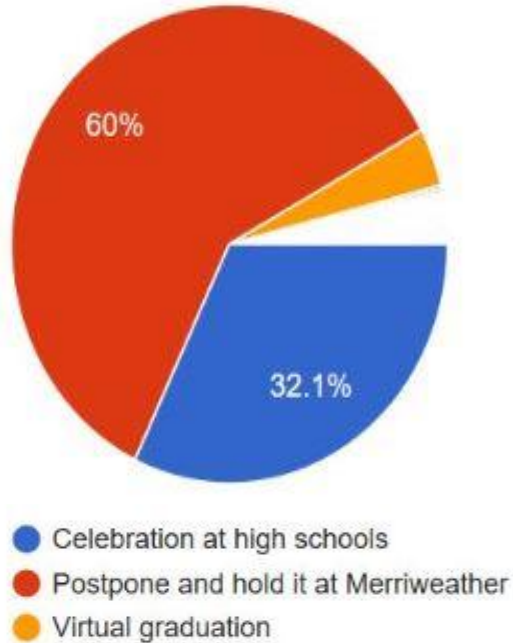


Senior Survey Analysis

Overview

- A survey was created for the class of 2020 to gather feedback on senior events and general attitudes considering everything going on with COVID-19
- Over 2,000 responses were received from all high schools including Homewood Center through multiple different surveys
- Generally speaking, students have no problem with postponements
- Responses were collected the week of April 3rd through 10th
- We continue to utilize the channels we have to reach out for updated feedback
- Weekly meetings with senior representatives

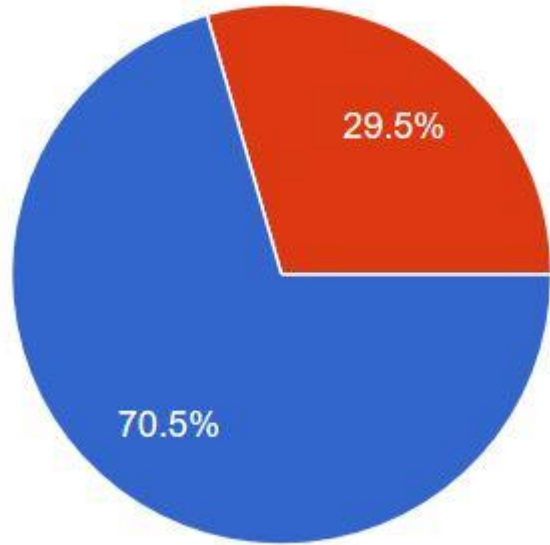
Graduation

- Students expressed that they would generally prefer to postpone graduation and hold it as normal as possible
- Celebration at high schools seemed to be a favorable backup plan
- Students show concern about refunds for cap and gown orders as well as honor cords

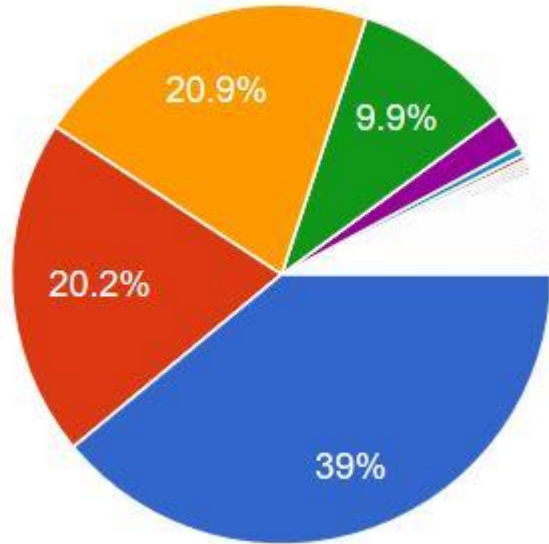
Prom
