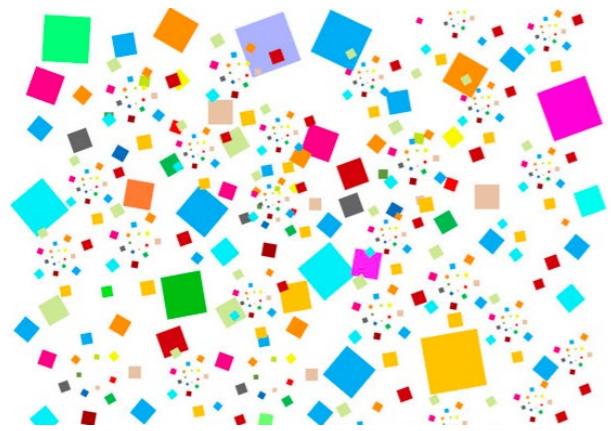

Please note, orientations/open houses for incoming kindergarteners will be scheduled and communicated in the spring and summer.

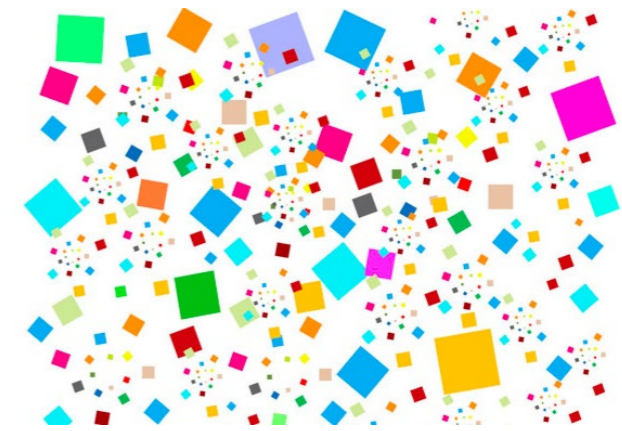

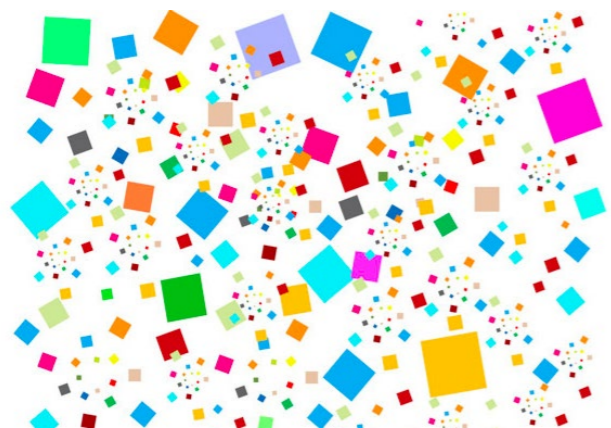

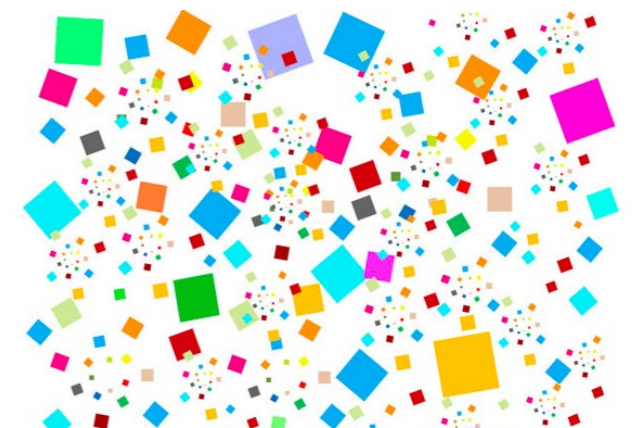
Exemptions



- 2,105 students were eligible for an exemption
- As of January 7, 2,015 families chose whether or not to elect the exemption
 - Approximately 84% chose to elect the exemption to stay at their current school
 - Approximately 10% chose not to elect the exemption to move to their redistricted school
- Staff are working with the families of the remaining 90 students who are eligible for an exemption but have not yet registered their choice

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January Transition Plans

- Schools can access lists of outgoing and incoming students through Synergy.
- Receiving schools will have access to incoming student data via Hoonuit.
- Schools hold orientations/welcome nights/open houses.
- January 13, 2020 - Receiving schools get School Messenger Lists with students new to schools.

Late January

- Determine program placement (e.g., special ed., pre-k, alt. ed., etc.) and staffing (e.g., reading specialists, school counselors, etc.)

Transition Activities

- **Staffing/Scheduling/Articulation Calendar:** Review the calendar for school visits, orientations/welcome sessions, and articulation dates
- Include receiving schools in meetings such as IEP and 504 Plan meetings
- Continue articulation between sending and receiving schools
- Include redistricted students in school visit days in May and June (including elementary students)
- Plan send-off activities for students being redistricted and other students leaving sending schools
- Continue to work with the Transition Committee at receiving schools to involve new families and continue the welcoming community
