A few Principals have brought it to our attention that families are attempting to acquire a 504 or IEP for their child so they may be exempt from redistricting - or edit an existing 504/IEP so they qualify for transportation services. I met with Caroline Walker and the technology team yesterday as they develop a new online version of the student reassignment form to organize this process. We preliminary decided in that meeting that we will only send the form to families who had an IEP/504 in place as of the Board's 11/21/2019 decision. That doesn't mean that there aren't special considerations that can be given if you feel it is in the best interest of the child.

Let me know if you have a different thought. They are developing the form now to go out Monday.

Hi Caroline,

I understand you may be the point person for figuring out redistricting exemptions? We are being asked to produce enrollments for next year and well as a list / report by school of who is transitioning somewhere else. Before we can create the enrollments and report, we need to understand and code in the exemption rules. If you, and/or your team are leading this up, can we

either meet and/or send you a list of questions about how this moves forward. For example, we saw in [the FAQ](#) that active military is exempt. We do have a question about active military in Family File, but we'd like to discuss if that will be the determinant, or if families will be given another opportunity to report their status? So with all of the exemptions, do families have a period of time to opt in / out and should we make some assumptions before we produce rosters?

I know this is all moving fast, so we're happy to get together whenever you are available.

Redistricting Exemptions

Hello PRES community,

At its meeting on November 21, 2019, the Board of Education voted to adjust school boundaries for next school year. If you are unsure if you are impacted by the boundary review you can find the BOE decisions here: [Board's decision and attendance area adjustments](#)

The decisions included several exemptions. Current 4th, 7th, 10th and 11th graders are exempt, as well as any student with an IEP/504 plan, those with at least one parent who is active duty military, and current River Hill High School and Oakland Mills High School students that are formally enrolled (as of 9/15/19) in either the 30-credit or 60-credit structured JumpStart program. **Current 9th graders and trailing siblings are not exempt from the Board decision.**

The exemption process is not yet open and will begin shortly. More information is forthcoming. We will keep you informed each step of the way.

Board Decisions Relative to Redistricting

At its meeting on November 21, 2019, the Board of Education voted to adjust school boundaries for next school year. This decision does impact students from Veterans Elementary School. If you are impacted, the decision included several exemptions. Current 4th, 7th, 10th and 11th graders are exempt, as well as any student with an IEP/504 plan, those with at least one parent who is active duty military, and current River Hill High School and Oakland Mills High School students that are formally enrolled (as of 9/15/19) in either the 30-credit or 60-credit structured JumpStart program. **Current 9th graders and trailing siblings are not exempt from the Board decision. This means that if you have a current 4th grader and there is a younger sibling, they must attend their new school in the 2020-2021 school year. Only the 4th grader will be considered for an exemption.**

The exemption process is not yet open and will begin shortly. More information is forthcoming. A form will be made available when ready in order to apply for the exemption.
