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Lt Reidy,

I received a call from a gentleman advising that his name was Joshua Lenes ([REDACTED]). He advised that he wanted to obtain a special event permit application for next week.

Mr. Lenes is planning a convoy of about 300 vehicles to meet at Howard High School on Tuesday, February 16, 2021, about 1700 hours. The convoy will travel to the Board of Education (Route 108) and stage within the parking lot of the Board of Education. He expects that the participants will stay within their vehicles. The event is expected to last until 1830 hours. The purpose of the event is to

bring attention to "Safe Schools". I asked Mr. Lenos to clarify what he meant about safe school (i.e. crime or COVID). He said COVID.

I advised him that his convey, which is a demonstration will have to follow the rules of the road, and no permit will be required (I told him about the 60-day minimal requirement if a permit was needed). I told him that I would notify the respective District in the event there was a problem with his event.
