- Remove and dispose of 6 pole lights and poles
Price: \$1,550.00
- Demo 6 existing pole bases and dispose of concrete
Price: \$3,300.00

Notes and Exclusions:

- Work to be done on normal hours (Monday – Friday 7-3)
- We will attempt to remove entire pole base, but if not possible we will remove down to at least 2' below grade.
- Existing pole base holes will be filled with dirt, compacted, seeded, and strawed.
