

INTRODUCTION

(Script for public comment and notice on agenda)

Public forum is the opportunity for members of the public to provide their views to the School Board and the comments are not meant to be the viewpoints of the School Board, the Superintendent, or the school system. At this time, if participants have material to be provided to the Board, please give it to the security officer and staff will ensure it is distributed to Board members.

In accordance with the Board Policy 2040:

The public forum may not be used to address:

- a. Individual personnel issues,
- b. Complaints identifying individual students,
- c. Matters that are on appeal,
- d. Topics for which the Board schedules formal public hearings, or
- e. Advertising or solicitation for products and/or services.

The Board expects that speakers deliver their comments with the decorum and respect appropriate to the conduct of the public's business. Given the Board meetings are broadcast and streamed, comments should be appropriate for all potential audience members. In accordance with Policy 1000, the Board encourages participants of Public Forum to refrain from using language that is indecent, profane, threatening, or abusive in nature.

Please be advised, however, that public comment may contain themes, language or behavior that viewers find objectionable and may not be suitable for younger viewers.
