1. Can you send me the link of Dr. Fauci's statement regarding school opening?
2. I appreciate your friend's calculation. She is correct that with 8 board members, there is a $36.3 \%$ chance of passing a motion if members vote randomly. If I use $C(n, m)$ to denote the combination of $n$ choose $m$.

Gridlock $=C(8,4) / 2^{\wedge} 8=27.34 \%$, Passing a motion $=\left(1-C(8,4) / 2^{\wedge} 8\right) / 2$ or $(C(8,5)+C(8,6)+C(8,7)+C(8,8)) / 2^{\wedge} 8=36.33 \%$.

With 7 members, there is a $50 \%$ chance of passing a motion if members vote randomly.

Passing a motion $=(C(7,4)+C(7,5)+C(7,6)+C(7,7)) / 2^{\wedge} 7=50 \%$.

With 8 members, the chance of passing a motion is smaller.
