

Feedback from September 15 PIP Meetings in Media Center

We appreciate the feedback from everyone who was able to join us in the media center on Wednesday or send feedback about the start to the school year. A few items to follow up on some themes we have heard as we continue to fine tune our processes returning everyone back to the building for the first time in 18 months:

- The amount of time it takes for everything we are doing is definitely longer than we are accustomed to in pre-COVID times. Planning, instruction, understanding student responses through their masks, grading -- it all seems to take more time and more energy. Know that you are not alone in this feeling, and let your ITL, departmental administrator and Marcy know if we can support you with anything or if you just need a listening ear.
- We have and will continue to hold students accountable for decisions that are contrary to school system policy and the student code of conduct. Accountability for our actions is a vital part of being in a community together.
- Staff members are always welcome and expected to hold students accountable for ontime attendance to class. If a student is habitually late, you are welcome to take the following steps:
 - conference with the student to understand the root cause of the lateness and collaborate on a plan to address the issue

- contact the student's parents/family members
- contact the student's Advocat, administrator, counselor, case manager, coach, advisor or other trusted adult
- assign the student to spend time with you outside of class to make up for missed class time and ensure clarity of expectations
- refer to the R&R process and/or administration
- With the elimination of hall duty, we appreciate staff members' presence in the halls between classes, when you are able, in order to support students' on time arrival to class
- Per Wednesday's announcements, the only acceptable lunch locations for students are:
 - o cafeteria
 - cafeteria patio
 - Peace Room
 - Gold Room
 - teacher classroom (with teacher permission)
 - media center (no food allowed)
- Some students may be assessing if they will be addressed by staff if they are not wearing their mask correctly. Please remind any student without a mask properly on their face to pull up and put on their mask.

Students with Food, Supplies, Resources Needs

- If you have any students who would benefit from extra food resources, the Corner Cafe' starts operations next week!
- If you have a student whom you believe would benefit from additional food resources, school supplies, heating/AC help at home, medical assistance, etc., please let the student's counselor and administrator know. We can connect with families to identify needs and connect with community resources.
