All the services were provided, but outside of general education instead of inside. This was for classroom instruction on [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]. This was from the start of the school year until 10/11 for 30 minutes daily. I actually have a phone call scheduled with the parent on Monday to understand better what she is asking for, but my understanding is that she is upset about the impact of her child being pulled outside the general education setting when he should not have been. This is understandable, but I am unsure of how we can compensate and replicate time inside the general education setting unless we double up on the in time. I'm just not sure that is reasonable for the staff to implement at this time. I will reach back out after I speak with the parent.
