Please give your immediate attention to this matter as it concerns with the safety of school bus riders crossing this bridge. DPW's Construction Inspection Division has instructed the trash and recycling truck to use the park entrance on Baltimore County side to serve the residents past this bridge which only has 10 tons capacity. All trucks including school buses weigh more than 15 tons. We've made repairs to the beams prior to the start of the replacement of this bridge, however, it only brought up the capacity to 10 tons. School bus do use this bridge everyday and there hasn't been any issue yet but that does not mean that it's safe to cross it. Please inform the school bus operators using this bridge that it's not safe to cross this bridge and if they do, it will be on their own risk.

There are two possible alternatives that I can think of at this point.

- 1. Route all the buses thru State park. This is the least favorable option as DNR indicated that they do not like to have school buses access this road especially the gravely road highlighted in yellow in



Good afternoon loe.

As you may be aware of the construction of Howard County's capital project no. B3831 - River Road over Rockburn Branch bridge replacement. Currently all the traffic has been shifted on the 10 ft. wide roadway section (upstream end) of the existing bridge with more impacts to exterior and first interior beams which were repaired and brought back to 10 tons capacity prior to the start of the construction. Existing roadway (asphalt) is currently supported by corrugated metal deck pans which has not much structural capacity left due to the extreme corrosion. In the past, trash & recycling trucks as well as school buses crossed the bridge without any issues because the majority of the live load (vehicular load) was centered over 5 interior beams which are in good shape. The recycling collection is every Tuesday and trash collection is every Friday before 9 am. The truck weight (empty) is 34,000 lbs which is beyond the existing weight capacity of the bridge.

Last Friday (5/23), County's inspector observed some depressions forming (circled in orange color below) on the roadway edges of the bridge deck due to the increased frequency of the heavy vehicles. After being aware of this situation, County immediately plated the entire bridge deck area with steel plates to prevent further damage. However, County is still concerned of these heavy trucks crossing the existing bridge and would like to request DNR to permit these trucks including school bus to utilize the park road as an alternate route. We anticipate one lane on the new bridge to be open to traffic by the end of August. We are looking for some direction with this matter very urgently.


